Active Voice

My, your, his, our, their.

All, many, several.

One, two, etc.

These processes describe actions or events e.g. He **ran** down the street or The boy **ate** the cake.

A verb is a word that indicates an action or a mental or physical state.

Male, English, working class.

When the subject of the sentence is doing the action, the verb is said to be in the active voice. E.g. The boy kicked the ball.

Relational processes report the relationship between a carrier and an attribute e.g. The girl **is** mad or The girl **has** problems.

These processes describe actions internal processes in our minds e.g. the girl **hoped** she would pass the exam or The girl **realised** she had not done enough work.
