One half is a condition (if) and the other half states the action to occur if the condition is to be met.

Lessens the force or intensity.

A statement that shows strong emotion.

Indicates certainty or possibility e.g. I **will** go to the shop, I **might** go to the shop.

Indicates a speaker or writer's attitude.

Is a type of dependant, or subordinate, clause that is missing a word or words.

Indicates desire e.g. I **love** going to the shop, I **need** to go to the shop.

Indicates obligation or necessity e.g. I **should** go to the shop, I **must** go to the shop.
