

As you evaluate the investigations and each 'station', you should ask yourself the following questions:

- Does the investigation allow for a focused approach?
- Is there enough quality data to allow for a successful investigation?
- Do the introduction and hypothesis make clear what the investigation will be focused on?
- Is the data and investigation presented in a helpful and easily understood way?
- Is the analysis detailed and evaluative with good textual support?
- Does the analysis consider relevant contextual factors which have impacted upon the way the data is produced and received?
- Are the conclusion and evaluation appropriate?
